In my most recent job, I worked at the Naval Air Warfare Center, Training Systems Division (NAWCTSD) in support of the Sailor 2025 Ready, Relevant, Learning (RRL) initiative. The RRL program is a major overhaul of Navy Schoolhouse training courses that modernizes the media with an array of blended learning solutions and PC-based simulations. My job was to collaborate with stakeholders and the Prime Contractor to ensure that all contract deliverables met specifications.

The RRL project also included an extensive Analysis phase that used a series of workshops with Navy Subject Matter Experts (SME). The Analysis workshops included: Job Duty Task Analysis (what to train), Rating Domain Analysis (when to train), Instructional Analysis and Media/Fidelity Analysis (how to train). The analysis workshops led to the creation of a Functional Requirements Document (FRD) that was used in the acquisition process. My primary role in these workshops was to serve as the lead facilitator using Microsoft Teams and other DoD conferencing tools.

My first project at General Dynamics was working on classified content for the Submarine Learning Center. I also worked designing and developing unclassified training for other Navy ratings. I was also able to greatly reduce the data entry time by creating a collection of MS Word macros to help edit the content and assist with moving the content into the AIM LOM system. This project used PowerPoint for storyboarding and Adobe Captivate to author the lessons.

The "Sim Ops" course was 70 hours of web-based training for Army S3 officers to obtain a certification in the military uses of modeling and simulation. Duties included assigning work to other IDs, reviewing content, designing the practical exercises, estimating schedules and tracking labor hours.
